Reasons for comment:

Comments:	1. Dangerous access to 350 houses - Potentially, 700 cars + Delivery and Service Vehicles using the A227 and Green Lane. This part of Wrotham Road is very busy particularly at school drop off and pick up times. This is exaggerated by schools opposite on the A227 and the local shops is particularly congested. It is already impossible to park at the shops most times of the day either outside in parking bays or the overspill car park. This development will make this worse. 2. The adjoining A227 is already at a standstill in the mornings at school drop off times. This development will add to this problem. 3. I have concern with the additional pressure this will put on the local GP practice, where it is already very difficult to get an appointment. 4. I have concerns at the additional pressure this development will put on local infrastructure and services including schools, public transport, drainage, statutory authorities etc. 5. The site adjoins conservation areas and will have a negative impact on these areas. 6. The site is high grade agricultural land farmed for centuries. 7. This is Greenbelt Land and should not be built on. 8. Large farmland site that contributes to food production that will be lost. 9. Loss of flora and fauna and wildlife habitats. 10. This development will significantly change the character of Meopham from village life to a town.
