| Comments: | <p>This proposed development is on prime agricultural land used for food production. This is NOT grey belt land referred to by the government for housing development. This therefore goes against the governments guidelines. It is very important to protect our agricultural land, to at least maintain food production and resilliance. We must look at food security in a world where this could quite easily become a pawn in diplomatic negotiations in the future. We must protect our green belt, particularly agricultural land.</p> <p>The development of 150 houses will potentially lead to an additional 300 cars, delivery and related servicing vehicles in a village setting.</p> <p>Access is proposed via a narrow country lane, totally unsuitable to service such a development and will almost certainly lead to congestion at peak times and dangerous black spots. The proximity to the A227 will lead to further traffic congestion on this road. There is already heavy congestion at peak times on this road. When there are problems on the M20 and/or A2, the A227 becomes heavily congested/gridlocked. With the Lower Thames Crossing being approved by the government, this will increase the congestion, even without this proposed development and the other 2 proposed developments around Meopham. The A227 is surrounded by narrow country roads, hence the whole area gets gridlocked. The proposed developments will just enhance the problems.</p> <p>This proposal will put added strain on our local infrstrucutre, GP, NHS and community services which are already stretched.</p> |
