Comments:	<p>This is a massive addition of houses on Green Belt land for which there are not adequate services</p> <p>It is hard enough to see a doctor as it is. The train services at Sole Street &amp; Meopham will struggle to cope with the additional passengers at peak times. The parking at Camer Parade shops is dangerously inadequate</p> <p>This will result in a huge increase in vehicle movements at peak times, adversely affecting the local highway infrastructure. This application must be considered in conjunction with the other major applications in Meopham including those next to Helen Allison School, Opposite Camer Parade and the expected application for land north of Norwood Lane. Collectively these applications propose at least 1,440 additional cars using the A227 in addition to service vehicles. It will lead to grid lock. Will the council be prepared to fund the cost of building new roads or making the A227 a dual carriageway? They cant even provide a footpath along the A227 between Meopham &amp; Istead Rise!</p> <p>This will change the nature of Norwood Lane which will cease to be a quiet Lane, it ill become a very busy main road</p> <p>This development should not be allowed on Green Belt land where there is a statutory presumption against development &amp; where there are insufficient reasons to allow the harm</p>
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This will erode the gap between the villages of Meopham & Sole Street,  
encouraging urban sprawl

This will adversely affect the setting of the Listed buildings of Bailiffs and Camer  
Barn
