Comments:	<p>I strongly object to the building of 120 houses adjacent to the Longfield Road near to the Helen Allison school. This is an SEN school and the needs of SEN pupils will be severely compromised.</p> <p>The whole school has been used to a calm environment and the extra housing and consequent traffic will have a severe impact on the welfare of the children and staff. Furthermore the proposed housing will be on high grade agricultural farmland dating back for many centuries and contributing to food production. The junction from the A227 to the Longfield road is already an area of severe traffic congestion involving cars and large lorries. The risk of air pollution will be severely increased. This in turn will have a vast impact on the SEN children and staff at the Helen Allison school and indeed the primary school next door. There is a severe parking problem at the 3 schools near the proposed site of new housing. This has a potential for severe accidents involving all these children.</p>
