Comments:	<p>This development would mean that Norwood Lane would have housing along its entire length and also along Green Lane towards Meopham. It would completely change the rural character of the area and result in increased traffic on a road already heavily used during the rush hour and when there are problems on the A2. This would make access to Green Lane from the development very difficult. This development, along with others in the immediate area will result in a significant increase in the number of cars trying to use narrow rural lanes.
