Reasons for comment:

Comments: I would object to this proposal on several key points relating to public safety, inordinate increased pressure on infrastructure including road usage and traffic volumes, schools, medical services. Certainly medical services, GPs and hospitals are already over stretched without significant increase in the local population that this proposal would create. I am concerned that the main roads - A227 and Green Lane - would not be able to cope with the increased volumes of traffic causing several delay potential and dangers to increased public safety - more accidents; more injuries; more medical attention required on overstretched hospital resources. The roads and medical services just cannot cope with this scale of expansion in the area. Substantial increase in traffic in areas of accident black-spots. We live in a rural area of greenbelt and this proposal again erodes the greenbelt and farming land - correspondingly food production is impacted at a time when we should be becoming a more self-sufficient country and utilising our natural resources of greenbelt and agricultural land.
