Comments:	Building 350 new houses on this greenfield site is shortsighted and inadvisable. Once developed, this beautiful field area will be gone forever. There are numerous brownfield land areas in Gravesham and these should be explored before even thinking of building in an area such as proposed here. More specifically, this land is currently agricultural and forms a critical part UK food production/security. The roads surrounding this area are narrow and totally ill-suited to the increased traffic that these homes will create - even the A227 is ill-suited to the additional traffic - it is frequently backed up near the primary school already at start and end of the school day so the congestion will simply be more extreme and lower the quality of living in the area..
