Comments:	<p>Think it will be incredibly detrimental to have a construction site next to a school which caters for children with extra needs. The noise pollution for these vulnerable children will be immense. The sensory overload they will be subjected to will be horrendous. The school is in this area as it is a peaceful and safe environment for the children. The loud noise pollution and extra air pollution will not be beneficial for the children attending Helen Allison School. The school depends on a calm, low noise environment and this will have a huge negative impact on the wellbeing of vulnerable children.</p> <p>The site is high grade agricultural land which has been farmed for centuries. The farming of this land contributes to this country's food production.</p> <p>Longfield Road is an extremely narrow road near to the junction with Wrotham road. This is exacerbated with residents' cars parked either side of the road and becomes highly congested during school drop off and pick up times.</p> <p>Longfield Road is constantly used by heavy vehicles going to the weigh bridge at Green Street Green.</p> <p>The Light pollution will have a massive environmental effect on the wildlife that live in this area, such as Redstarts, Tawny Owls, Sky Larks, Buzzards, Bat, Badgers, Foxes etc.</p> <p>In such a rural area any new homes will have an immense effect on Light pollution and Air pollution and as this site is so close to a school I don't believe the increase in air pollution would be beneficial for children who are already extremely vulnerable.</p>
