Comments:	<p>The road A227 and Longfield road are very busy, especially in the morning, with drivers going towards Dartford when the A2 is congested. Also many lorries go down that way, making traffic worse.</p> <p>This proposal is cutting into agricultural land, so will cut into green belt land yet again. The A227 is heavily used at all times of the day by vehicles heading towards the A20 or the A2, and most local vehicles must use this road at least twice a day. The A227 is too narrow for current high usage and when anything stops the flow, the surrounding lanes are often completely blocked. Buses are so rare as to be useless, and most train commuters have to get to the station by road. More homes will increase this pressure on the roads.</p> <p>It is getting impossible to make a doctor's appointment, and local people are often told they must use the Community walk-in NHS service in Gravesend - leading to more car journeys. Extra families will add to this strain.</p> <p>SEN children generally need peaceful surroundings, so building nearby will cause more issues for them and remove their rural setting.</p>
