Comments:	I am objecting to this building development on a number of grounds:  1) Meopham is entirely unsuitable for large scale building development due to the extreme pressure from its current residents on its services and infrastructure. 2) The A227 has not seen significant improvements since the 1930s and should be a B road not an A road. The road is a catastrophe at school times and the rush hours. If there is any disruption on this road such as road works or an accident the traffic queues can stretch for many miles. 3) Green lane is narrow to the point where 2 opposing vehicles can have a difficult time getting past each other. Additionally, the corner at Camer Park has very limited visibility. This development would add much more traffic to this road, making it even more dangerous. 4) This development would add additional stress to already overstretched facilities such as doctors, schools and parking. 5) This development would obliterate extremely valuable agricultural land and deprive local wild life of habitat. 6) This development would forever alter the character of this wonderful village. This development is an affront to the people of Meopham and should be resoundingly rejected.
