Comments: I would like to object to the above proposal.

The A.227 is already a rat run, used by vehicles travelling from the M.20/M.25/M.26 as a cut through to the A.2 and Dartford Crossing. This includes container lorries which should not be allowed, as the road is too narrow. This situation will get worse with the proposed new Thames Crossing.

The A.227 can be subjected to flooding in various places and anymore infrastructure will make matters worse.

A potential 350 houses will cause a lot more vehicles using the road for trips to schools, shops and the station. I live near the station and when using it, I have to allow adequate time to just cross the road which can take ages at peak times. I hasten to add that much of this traffic exceeds the speed limit, making it exceedingly dangerous.

In addition to this, the local schools and medical facilities will not be able to cope with all these extra residents. They are all over subscribed now.

This is prime agricultural land, which should be used for producing food. Kent used to be known as The Garden of England. However, it is increasingly becoming a concrete jungle. Meopham will no longer be a Village. It is just so sad.

Please do not allow this proposed development to go ahead.
