Comments:	<p>I object to this application. This plot of green belt land is totally unsuitable for housing of this nature. The land can be prone to flooding. Already the run off from side roads onto the main A227 causing drainage problems to motorists or pedestrians. Light pollution needs to be considered more and given greater credence as this can seriously affects the quality of life of those living nearby. Also it affects the established wildlife that cannot maintain habitat when disturbed by light. This proposed development would desecrate the character of the village as Meopham is essentially a rural community. For example our local medical GP surgery and medical services are at capacity already and will not cope with further demands. Families who have invested in living in a more rural area should be respected and supported not penalised by depleting services or desecrating a way of life by encroaching on the boundaries of their community. The A227 is already a dangerous road and further building of homes will unnecessarily add to those having to negotiate the A227 every day either accessing or indeed travelling along it to schools. Schooltime traffic is at an alarmingly busy level already. Exiting my property at most times of the day becomes increasingly more dangerous. Please reject this proposed development as unnecessary.</p>
