This is conservative as many houses will have 2/3 cars<br>Downs Road is already being used by drivers whom do not adhere to the speed limit and will become a busy major road for access<br>Doctors, Dentist and hospitals cannot work efficiently at the moment, more patients means more delays and a worse service.<br>The local shops car park is full at many times of the day, another 154 houses> please advise where they will park<br>The bus service is roughly 1 per hour and doesn't offer a regular service at the moment.<br>Primary school is already working at pupils maximum, where will the new children entering the village if the go ahead is given, attend school?<br>This is a car dependant community for travel<br>extra housing in no way benefits the local community at the moment and puts extra pressure in all areas of living. |
