Comments:	Transport Impact: The development would lead to a significant increase in traffic congestion in the village and surrounding areas. There is already significant traffic build up at peak times, especially around the two schools in the village and the parade of shops, where a central road island and kerbside posts have had to be installed to prevent illegal parking in these areas.
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This project significantly undermines the purposes of the green belt: to safeguard the countryside - in this case farmland, hedges and trees, to retain the character of this historic village and to prevent urban sprawl. This is particularly relevant as this is one of several proposed applications.

There will also be increased pressure on the village GP surgery, schools and nurseries.
