Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	I strongly oppose this proposal due to the unacceptable impact on the Green Belt, local services, road safety, pollution levels and wildlife.  The land remains protected Green Belt within the Gravesham Borough Council Local Plan. Development here has not been justified, and the scheme fails to provide any valid exceptional circumstances. This open countryside contributes to our rural identity, supports farmland, stores carbon and helps manage flooding. It also provides a vital separation between villages and expanding urban areas.  Essential infrastructure is already under serious pressure. Darent Valley Hospital, local GP surgeries and secondary schools are struggling to cope with existing demand, and there are limited further education opportunities locally. This development would intensify those issues without sufficient support or investment.  Traffic in the area is constantly congested, particularly when major routes such as the A2, M2 and M20 are affected. Increased vehicle movements would heighten risks around the nearby primary and Special Educational Needs school, where parking and visibility are already a concern for children's safety.  The scheme also threatens increased air and light pollution and would remove natural habitats, including trees, hedges and areas used by protected species.

I therefore ask that this application is refused.
