Comments:	<p>Longfield Road is not wide enough to cope with the current level of traffic and parking now let alone with an increase of traffic that would be associated with this number of houses. In addition the A227 is often clogged up at peak times and this development will only make that worse.</p> <p>Helen Allison school is for children with autism many of whom will be adversely affected by the increase in noise and people right next to the school.</p> <p>Meopham would require an increase in school places - where is the new school?</p> <p>Meopham Medical Centre is massively overstretched now with hardly any appointments available so the situation would be even worse unless a new surgery was also factored into the plans.</p> <p>I understand the need for more homes in Gravesham but Meopham is a village on the green belt. Surely a more suitable site could be found that could also accommodate the infrastructure required for this number of houses.</p>
