Comments:	<p>The aspect of this application that most concerns me is the impact on NHS services. I am now 71 and have significant health issues. My wife is 64, has survived cancer and now has Parkinsons. Both of us need our GP more than the average patient. But NHS statistics show that already the ratio of patients to doctors in Meopham is around 1: 2000, higher by one third than the average for Kent and Medway which stands at around 1: 1500. It is already difficult to get an appointment, if this application is granted we will have thousands of new patients seeking medical services. If this application and other similar applications are granted, the situation will become impossible. If the Council is minded to grant this application and similar ones, it is essential that medical services are expanded at the expense of the developers to meet the demand. Increased provision must be in place at the time any houses go up, otherwise the outlook for us and other people with chronic health problems and/or disabilities will be grim.</p>
