Comments:	<p>The junction of Wrotham Road and Longfield Road is very dangerous at the moment, even more so since the road has been narrowed by the parade of shops. When I travel from the village hall to the tollgate on the A227 at 7am the traffic coming out of Green lane and cutting across to Longfield Road is bumper to bumper, this is used as a rat run due to the A2 always being congested. A few weeks ago when road works were in force by the George pub it was pandemonium it took 1 and a half hours to get from the village hall to the parade of shops. It is very difficult to get out of our property near the village hall due to the vast amount of traffic now using the A227, we even have to time it right to come back to our property at school times due to cars parked on the road and even over our driveway. Traffic does not keep to the speed limit either. It is hard to get a doctors appointment now due to more residents, it will become even worse if these houses go ahead. The A227 and roads leading off of it were not constructed to take such high volumes of traffic, more houses would mean more traffic.</p>
