Comments:	<p>My reasons for objecting are as follows:</p> <p>The initial development of the site will cause noise, dust and disturbance which will not be good for the children at Helen Allison school. I think it is likely that many of the children have sensory sensitivity and the building work will be detrimental to their mental and emotional health.</p> <p>Traffic travelling along Longfield road is often blocked and slowed by parked cars. This will get worse if a new estate is built nearby. Many parents bring children to Meopham schools from surrounding villages and towns which adds to congestion.</p> <p>The county is rapidly losing quality agricultural land to development.</p> <p>There is not enough capacity in local schools, GP surgeries and hospitals to support a significant increase to the population of the village.</p>
