This application should be looked at with others in close proximity to this development . As it will impact on infrastructure and road systems which are poor and at present over used during rush hours

It is very close to National Landscape and will impact on the wildlife and dark skys and ecosystems.And pollution caused by more traffic

The loss of grade 2 agricultural land which has been continuously farm for centuries is detrimental to food supply in this country and should not be considered as grey belt land it is definitely green belt

The houseing needs survey did not produce the numbers of need to this extent .

The schools Doctors water and power annd drainage are not able to support the current population in this part of North Kent , the hospital is running at capacity .

We have large developments in close proximity to this site which will overwhelm the area , also Ebbsfleet garden city is with less than 5 miles of the huge number of homes that are in for planning at the moment at New Ash Green and Bough green will all use the same road net work to access the motorway network

The rail service is sometimes standing room only and the bus service is disconnected and infrequent and none on Sunday

The road is not safe for cyclists and has a number of pinch points

And has collapsed with a sink hole , the detour was 17 miles to get to other end of the village and took weeks to repair.

The minor roads cannot cope with increased traffic as most are single track . And poorly maintained

These developments are not looking at local need and will expensive, the

developers will not provide affordable housing for local people they will do all they can to build large expensive houses with several cars
These developments will increase our village by about 1/3 of the current population in with any improvement to the infrastructure
The exit to this development is at point where two vehicles have difficulty in passing , the route to Sole Street station is dangerously narrow with no paths and part of the National landscape,
I hope this development will be looked at with care and consideration for existing population who overwhelmingly do not want this development
