Comments:	<p>The access point for this site opposite Camer Parade is onto a very busy and dangerous section of the A227. An extra 700 vehicles would result in further congestion, a rise in vehicle emissions and more accidents, both after the site is occupied and during construction.</p> <p>The site at Wrotham Road should be considered alongside the Longfield Road and West of Norwood Lane applications which totals 620 homes. Potentially, 1,440 extra vehicles using the same small area of road onto the A227 as the main route in and out of Meopham.</p> <p>The A227 is often congested and is used as a shortcut when nearby major roads face problems, causing local side roads to become overwhelmed. Highways England reports that traffic on the A227 will increase with the completion of the Lower Thames Crossing.</p>
