Comments:	<p>- Dangerous access junction onto the A227 both east and westbound which supports assess to two separate schools i.e. Meopham Community Academy and Helen Allson school for Autistic Children. During school times, queuing and parked vehicles are very heavy creating hazards for both passing vehicles and pedestrians. Meopham Community Academy is already oversubscribed and children from Helen Allson school are vulnerable pupils that may require close supervision around traffic. This application could therefore be severely detrimental to the above factors.</p> <p>- Traffic volumes would be increased by this application to a Village unable to cope with the higher level of population and vehicles.</p> <p>- This application would put further pressure on our already overstretched GP Medical Centre which currently subscribes to approximately 9,500+ patients, who already struggle to secure timely appointments.</p>
