Comments:	I strongly object to this development proposal. The Longfield Road is a fast road quickly coming into a narrow residential and already packed road meaning an increase in cars will cause it to become dangerous. Especially taking into consideration that it is alongside 2 schools, one being a SEN school. It will also cause Melliker Lane (which is already used as a cut through for many vehicles, some that are too big and drive way too fast) to become unmanageable. This is a narrow lane and cars struggle to pass as it is currently let alone when a possible 200+ extra cars have the access as well. Cars are already forced into the bushes and scratched along this lane, having this many more cars will make it impossible to get through meaning current residents will struggle getting out of their own driveways and along the lane that they live. It is also highly, highly dangerous pulling into Melliker lane from the main Longfield Road, if there are more than two cars coming from the main road that meet one other car coming from Melliker lane, this causes a backlog/stop on the main, extremely fast road - having more cars using this could cause some serious accidents.
