Comments:	The Helen Allison School is a SEN school, with all pupils being delivered by road, majority of which are taxi's, the morning rush is heavily congested and the access is not the safest. As a SEN school many of the pupils will be sensitive to noise and sensory overload, have the construction of hundreds of houses will potentially cause them harm and distress.
	The Longfield road is narrow with residents having no alternative apart from parking outside their houses, many have collision warnings fitted to their vehicles due to the number of collisions occurring, most of which are not reported
	This application is also not the only proposed development in the immediate vicinity, these should not be looked at in isolation, with application 20250992 and 20251116 also looking for approval for an additional 500 houses, including this one a total of 620. This will result in thousands of vehicles using already congested roads not designed for significant traffic.
	High quality farm land is being destroyed and the infrastructure in the village will not cope with these additional houses.
