Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	I wish to object to this application due to significant concerns about road safety and the suitability of Longfield Road for accessing a development of this scale. The proposal would require dangerous access for 120 houses, potentially adding over 240 cars as well as delivery and service vehicles to a stretch of road that is already hazardous. Longfield Road is constantly used by heavy vehicles travelling towards Green Street Green. These large vehicles already make the road difficult to navigate, especially at busy times, and increasing traffic volumes alongside them would create an unsafe environment for all road users. In addition, the speed limit on this section of Longfield Road is 50mph, and many vehicles continue at that speed as they approach residential properties and the nearby schools. This speed is entirely inappropriate for an access point serving a large housing development. Introducing a significant number of vehicles turning in and out of a new junction at this speed creates a clear risk of serious accidents. For these reasons, I do not believe Longfield Road is safe or suitable for providing access to 120 new homes.
