Comments:

I do not agree with the proposal for the following reasons:

- 1) The proposed development is on agricultural Green Belt land.
- 2) Wrotham Road is already a very busy road with severe traffic congestion in the mornings and afternoons at school start and finish times. There is a considerable amount of heavy goods traffic which will be exacerbated when the Lower Thames Crossing is completed.
- 3) with the majority of households now having two cars, an estimated 700 plus additional cars plus service and delivery vehicles will add considerably to congestion with the additional access between Green Lane and the Church on to the Wrotham Road.
- 4) Parking is already a problem during school start and finish times (Junior and Meopham Academy).
- 5) The possibility of an additional 1000 plus people to our village will put a further strain on our water supply, schools, GP services and an already stretched Hospital.
- 6) Pedestrian safety will be compromised particularly around the parade of shops.
