Comments:	<p>This application will negatively impact on the well being of vulnerable children as well as local residents, increasing noise and population.</p> <p>Longfield Road is narrow with residents parking and highly congested at school start and finish times. It is already dangerously used by heavy vehicles going to the weigh bridge at Green Street Green. The speed limit is not adhered to by many moving from the 50mph stretch to the area of this application.</p> <p>The A227, especially near Longfield Road, Green Land and Camer Parade is already a potential death trap - increased local population will only lead to accidents.</p> <p>It is high grade farmland used for our food production- this should be maintained to avoid increasing food imports.</p> <p>Meopham is already oversubscribed and services including NHS are overstretched.
