Comments:	<p>I object to this plan for the following reasons:</p> <p>I feel strongly that the character of the area of villages be maintained. It is important to protect this for future generations to enjoy as part of their local heritage and history. Once this is built on, then generations to come can only learn via images and stories rather than experiencing for themselves.</p> <p>If the proposal were to go ahead, it would have serious impact with regard to traffic, noise and pollution in the surrounding area during construction. This would impact not only residents but also wildlife in the wider area (wildlife that includes protected species) not just the construction site itself. I believe the damage done would not recover and the loss of wildlife permanent. I understand that the plan is next to ancient woodland and I object most strongly to this protected area being impacted in any way.</p> <p>Once built, the impact of increased vehicles on A227 and local villages would be apparent as there is a distinct lack of local public transport. I understand that a percentage of housing is stated as "affordable" but affordable to who? Would local key workers for example be able to afford the housing proposed? Whilst I understand housing stock is needed, local villages are not best placed to support an increase in commuters.</p> <p>I see very little if anything to support this application and therefore object.</p>
