Comments:	<p>I live in Meopham</p> <p>I object to this development because</p> <p>1 the junction of longfield road and wrotham rd A227 is dangerous and often a bottleneck .especially at school times. People need to park to drop off at the three schools there.</p> <p>2 the A227 is often gridlocked especially if there are roadworks etc. The A227 is often used as a rat run when there is trouble on the A2 or M20. Drivers get frustrated and do not stick to the 30 mph speed limit. More cars from this site plus the other developments close by , will cause further chaos. And this is at a place where there are lots of children from the three schools plus another close by.</p> <p>3 there are already issues with parking , this just adds to it.</p> <p>4 there is a cumulative effect from not just this site but the other two in existence plus others coming shortly.</p> <p>5 this is beautiful countryside ...green belt and prime agricultural land. we cannot give this up.....you cant grow food on concrete.</p> <p>brownfield sites and grey belt should be where we are building, close to jobs . because cars are needed in this area. very few people actually use the train daily for work.</p> <p>6 this land is mean as a buffer between other villages. you are just adding to the urban/rural sprawl. It sets a dangerous precedent.</p> <p>7 Why do we need it here ? because this is where the developers can make most money. Affordable housing ? i think not in this area.....too expensive. plus people</p>
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will need to run a car.

8 this land acts as a natural drain to prevent flooding . Once this goes, more problems will appear.

9 there s all sorts of wildlife around here. they need to be protected.

10 more housing near 3 schools , clogging up the junctions , is going to increase air pollution and that will affect those children.
