Comments:	I am writing to strongly object to the proposed development. I have serious concerns about the impact that the development would have on local services and roads. There has been a steady increase in the amount of traffic on the road system over the last few decades, now there are almost weekly occasions where there are major delays because of a road closure or accident on one of the main road arteries. I wish that I had kept a diary, to quote to you, of the number of times that major delays have occurred, caused by an incident on the A2, M2, M20, M26 or other major local road. The proposed local developments would add more and more traffic to a system that is already, regularly unable to cope. An example of the effect this has had: Specifically, I know of a number of occasions where a local primary school has had to delay the start of the school day because so many of its staff were absent, because they were trapped in traffic hold ups and therefore they didn't have enough staff to start classes. I am also concerned about the effect of the extra demand on the medical services, schools and nurseries, that would reduce availability for all of us. I have loved living in this part of Kent for over 60 years, and I am proud of its environmental beauty. The proposed development would have a seriously detrimental impact on the landscape, historic setting and wildlife habitats. I'm also puzzled to know why the government want to build so many more houses. I know that a company who have built a local newly built housing estate are struggling to sell the smart new houses that they have built. Please reconsider and don't build new houses on this beautiful countryside.
