Comments:	I do not agree with the proposal for the following reasons: 1) The proposed development is on agricultural Green Belt land. 2) Longfield Road is a busy, narrow road connecting with New Barn and Longfield, with many residents cars parked on both sides, down past the Helen Allison school. This parking problem is made worse by additional cars parking at school drop-off and collection times. The road is at these times reduced to single track road. 3) Additional houses lead to increased water demand (already a regular summer problem) , and more demand for stretched GP services.
