Comments:	<p>I strongly object to this outline planning application for any residential dwellings on this site. This is greenbelt land and has not been released from the greenbelt boundary. It is highgrade farmland which is used to contribute to our food production which our country must retain.</p> <p>Norwood Lane is a country lane with limited road width and beautiful individual properties along parts of it. To construct a housing estate of up to 150 residential dwellings, including affordable dwelling, would devalue the vicinity and deprive the current residents of their surrounding natural beauty and would be a travesty. It would also statistically mean an additional 300 cars will be using a tiny lane which, in some parts, has only passing areas for cars and no footpath. The additional potential 300 residents will add strain to Meopham's already overfull facilities eg schools, medical centres, hospitals etc.</p> <p>The outline application is also for public open space but we, as a rural village, are lucky enough to be able to enjoy our existing public open spaces so we must protect our community for our future generations.</p> <p>Meopham does not have the infrastructure to cope with an influx of additional inhabitants</p> <p>I urge our Local Planning Authority to consider these comments and other objections and reject this outline application in full.</p>
