Comments:	As a resident of Wrotham Road I am objecting to these plans based on the fact that the A227 is currently not fit for purpose (as it has frequent roadworks and traffic restrictions) and would not be able to cope with any additional traffic. There are no plans to improve the traffic network. The other roads in this area are generally single track and would not be suitable for any increase in use. The population increase in Meopham would not be supported by the schools, surgery, bus and train services. The green belt areas would be affected by this building. Additional consideration needs to be given to the distress that the pupils of the Helen Allison School with the SEN status would endure. Longfield Road is already very busy with the existing school traffic and would become a deathtrap.
