<ul style="list-style-type: none">* The scheme intrudes into the rural landscape, disrupting long-established views and the character of the countryside* The design and layout are out of keeping with the established character of the village, undermining its identity.* Local schools and healthcare facilities are already at capacity, and the development provides no clear mitigation for this pressure* There are no adequate public transport links, meaning residents would be car-dependent, contrary to sustainable transport policies.* The site supports diverse habitats, and the development would fragment wildlife corridors and threaten protected species* This scheme would result in the permanent loss of valued open countryside, eroding the green buffer between communities.* The location is inappropriate, lying outside the defined settlement boundary and undermining planned growth strategies
