Comments:	This would significantly increase the volume of traffic in Meopham and access and exit from the estate would be extremely dangerous during peak hours as already shown at Meopham shops.
	The visual impact would significantly change the environment from being a village into a town.
	Meopham does not have the infrastructure to accommodate such an increase in population - overstretched GP and NHS services, school places, very little bus service, crowded trains & platforms during peak hours.
	This is currently active farmland used for food production, and is full of birds and wildlife.
	The A227 is already used as a cut-through between motorways and is completely jammed at peak/school times and is not designed to accommodate the amount of Lorries and delivery vehicles that use it. This would only get worse with additional housing.
	This would be a massive increase in the population of a village that already has inadequate transport links.
