Comments:	<p>This increase in housing would significantly increase the volume of traffic using Longfield Road and therefore the junction with the A227, already a dangerous and very busy access point.</p> <p>Longfield Road is very narrow at the A227 junction with a large number of parked cars at all times, especially at school drop off and collection times and therefore dangerous to children.</p> <p>The Meopham infrastructure cannot accommodate a significant increase in population, with an overstretched GP service, virtually non-existent and bus service, inadequate pathways and no cycle routes.</p> <p>Any additional increase in the A227 traffic would bring it to a standstill during peak hours.</p> <p>The proposed site is on agricultural land used for food production and would have a significant detrimental impact to the landscape.</p>
