Comments:	<p>I have lived in Meopham for 34 years and have used Longfield Road many times. Not only has the traffic increased, but the speed at which people drive into the village, quite often breaking at the last minute, which would be around where the access to the new development would be.</p> <p>For the amount of extra traffic proposed and with the slower speed of turning into/out of the new street, there is a high possibility of accidents occurring. The road gets heavily congested during school pick up/drop off times, with parking on both sides of the road and in Huntingfield. With more cars and parking further along the road, there would only be a matter of time before an accident would occur.</p> <p>I strongly object to the development, as the amount of traffic would increase, making Longfield Road very dangerous. With more children presumably living in the houses and walking to school, or being driven to school, plus more commuters, the congestion would cause a major bottleneck. Throw into the mix the many heavy goods vehicles that use the route as a cut through, a bad accident is waiting to happen.</p>
