Comments:	I wish to object to the outline planning application for 120 homes at Longfield Road next to the Helen Allison School. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Highway and safety risks: Longfield Road already experiences heavy congestion at school drop-off and pick-up times. Adding 120 dwellings will significantly worsen traffic and increase risks for children attending Helen Allison School, where vulnerable pupils already require enhanced safety measures.</li><li>- Insufficient local infrastructure: Local GP practices, schools and public services are already over capacity. The application does not demonstrate that these essential services can accommodate the additional population, making the proposal unsustainable.</li><li>- Harm to Green Belt purposes: Although described as "grey belt," the site still performs important Green Belt functions—especially safeguarding the countryside from encroachment. Building on this land would contribute to urban sprawl and permanently erode the rural character of the area.</li></ul>
For these reasons, I urge the council to refuse this application.
