Comments:	<p>As a visitor to Meopham where my daughter and her husband live, I would like to object to the application to build 350 houses in an already busy part of the village. Being at a precarious junction where Green Lane and Longfield road join the Wrotham road this area is already a potential accident blackspot. Coupled with the fact that Meopham Community Academy and Pre School are very close to the site. adding 350 homes and numerous additional cars will only exasperate the situation. Traffic using the shopping parade often at peak times around school opening or closing causes parking problems on the Wrotham road. This will be at the exact point the development is being planned. With this number of properties in such a small area how many additional cars truck and delivery vehicles will enter the new estate from the Wrotham road? There is little provision for safe crossing of the road during busy times at present . This situation will be more difficult with a further road entrance to contend with. Consideration should also be given to the impact on Green Lane. Additional traffic will surely clog what is currently a quiet rural lane leading to potential danger approaching the Wrotham road. The building of the new housing estate does not take in to account the safety of people living and visiting this beautiful village in Kent.</p>
