Comments:	I strongly object to Planning Ref. 20251116. The village of Meopham has already reached saturation point. The A227 as it stands is not fit for purpose without adding to the daily chaos. The A227 is narrow, has sink holes, floods regularly and is very difficult to negotiate crossing from one side to the other. This manoeuvre is particularly dangerous for young children and the elderly. The Lower Thames Crossing, when it opens, is something not to look forward to. Norwood Lane and Green Lane already have to cope with an excessive amount of lorries unbecoming especially for a village. The GP service is already overstretched and the nearest hospital at Dartford has limited capacity. Flooding and sewage overspill is a regular occurrence along Norwood Lane without potentially another 300 villagers adding to the problem.
