High grade agricultural land/green belt should not be built on.3. Any additional house-building in Meopham will bring an unacceptable rise in population which cannot be supported by existing NHS/Docotors' Surgery and local schools, already full. Traffic to Meopham School at peak times is queued back for over a mile and access to the Doctor's surgery on the same site is impossible.4. WATER! Has any consideration been to provision of water and sewage? Kent already suffers with shortages/hosepipe bans during very dry years, and at the other end, after prolonged rai fall, undiluted sewage is pumped into our rivers and seas: these situations are unacceptable now and with additional house-building will only get worse - an environmental disaster.
