Comments:	<p>This would result in a dangerous access to an already extremely busy area. 120 houses with on average 2-3 cars per household.</p> <p>Development next to Helen Allison School with pupils who have special needs. The additional housing so close to the school would impact on their wellbeing. Longfield Road is extremely narrow and already has to be navigated with care due to parked vehicles in and around this spot.</p> <p>This road is a known shortcut for heavy lorries destined for the weigh bridge at Green st Green.</p> <p>The unnecessary loss of grade agricultural land farmed for centuries and providing a food source.</p> <p>Travelling through Longfield Road to Meopham is a 50mph speed limit. Vehicles frequently do not slow down approaching the school and junction.</p> <p>A highly dangerous area to even consider any further developments with the additional traffic going to the shops.</p>
