Comments:	I strongly object to this proposal. The main Wrotham road is already busy making it difficult at time to pull out from side roads. When the two schools on Longfield Road are at their busy times it is already extremely congested and side roads such as Melliker Lane cannot cope with the traffic using these as cut throughs, even currently let alone with the possibility of so many more cars. Roads such as these are narrow and only intended for residents, when many cars use it there is congestion and cars being forced into bushes to pass each other. The meopham parade of shops are already constantly (and I mean constantly) full and busy with cars, it is very dangerous pulling out of the exit into the main road as there is a black spot, more cars using this from directly opposite will cause a near impossible situation when trying to exit the shops. The current volume of cars using the Wrotham Road is high, the potential addition to this with any of these proposals will be highly inappropriate and disruptive to our lovely, rural village.
