Comments:	<p>At the moment, we have three planning applications nearby, and since this area is designated as greenbelt land, it really should be preserved.</p> <p>The A227 is already quite crowded, and bringing in another 1,500 cars could create serious challenges for us all. We also need to think about how the access and buildings next to Helen Allison School, which supports students with special educational needs, will impact these children. They are particularly sensitive and this development could lead to feelings of alarm, stress, and sensory overload, which can disrupt the calm environment that is so important for their wellbeing.</p> <p>Let's not forget that this land has been used for farming for generations and is essential for food production. Plus, the pollution levels affecting both schools on Longfield Road would likely rise significantly, especially during busy times at the start and end of the school day, making things even more difficult for our children.</p> <p>We must consider the safety and overall wellbeing of our community! This development will cause dangerous access and traffic volumes.</p>
