Comments:	<p>I wish to formally object to this change of use from C3 that of a dwellinghouse to a residential care home for children/teenagers and their needs to C2use, whereby a full planning permission would be required because a different pattern of activity is created than that of a normal dwelling.</p> <p>The property is within a quiet residential area comprised of family homes. The change of use represents a substantial departure from the existing residential character of the neighbourhood. The care home would require 24 hour support from support staff/regular visits from external medical/social workers/therapists along with educational safeguarding officers. The effect of this increased footfall, vehicles presents legitimate concerns for the amenity of nearby residents.</p> <p>Parking provision/traffic management hasn't really been adequately addressed in the appn . and the anticipated no. of staff/visiting professionals far exceeds that which the local area streets could reasonably accommodate, raising potential issues around highway safety, & obstruction of what is already a limited residential parking environment.</p> <p>A children's home doesn't in any way meet the definition of C3b single household requirement use as by its very nature is not a single household, and the operational characteristics/activities take the use well beyond the scope of what C3b permits.</p>
