Comments:	<p>I object to this application for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Risk to Children Attending the Nearby SEN School Introducing a large number of vehicle movements so close to Helen Allison School will create unnecessary anxiety, distraction and danger for pupils, many of whom are especially sensitive to noise and disruption.</li><li>2. Traffic Congestion During Drop-off &amp; Pick-up Times The road is already gridlocked at school times. Adding more daily traffic will increase risk and frustration for parents, carers and staff, and make both arrival and departure less safe.</li><li>3. Road Too Narrow and Heavily Parked Cars already park along this road, leaving insufficient space for safe passing. More vehicles will worsen this and increase the likelihood of accidents.</li></ol>
Conclusion:	This development would compromise the safety and wellbeing of vulnerable children and the wider community, and should be refused.
