### Reasons for comment:

Comments:	There are not enough resources within meopham to support such a large-scale development. The roads cannot support the current traffic, let alone hundreds more cars. The infrastructure is also severely lacking including pipework (water/sewage systems). Including issues with a severe lack of health resources such as GP's and a lack of educational resources, such as schools. The impact on the local environment would be immense. We need to protect our green spaces not continuously and constantly destroy them. Our ecosystem depends on protecting what little green areas we have remaining.  I do not think Meopham is capable of sustaining an increased population. The basic necessary infrastructure, including roads/pipework as mentioned previously, is incredibly lacking. Public services is also extremely poor including, as previously mentioned, school access, doctor access and public transport. It is simply ludicrous that such a proposal has been put forward with no, to limited, accounting of the issues such a dramatic population increase will cause.
