Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	I wish to raise a strong objection on the grounds of highway safety and severe traffic congestion on Longfield Road.
	Longfield Road is an extremely narrow residential street, with cars parked along both sides, leaving very limited space for vehicles to pass safely. The road is already highly congested, particularly during school start and finish times, when traffic levels peak and visibility is significantly reduced. Introducing additional traffic from the proposed development would worsen an already unsafe situation.
	Furthermore, the road is frequently used by heavy vehicles, which adds further strain to the limited road width and increases the risks for pedestrians, schoolchildren, and residents. The current road layout is not suitable for accommodating any additional traffic without causing serious safety concerns.
	For these reasons, I strongly object to the proposed development on the basis that it would materially worsen traffic congestion and significantly compromise highway and pedestrian safety.
