Comments:	<p>As someone with many years of public service experience, I am particularly concerned about the situation on Longfield Road. The road is notably narrow, with residents' vehicles parked along both sides, which leads to severe congestion, especially during school opening and closing times. Heavy goods vehicles regularly use this route to access the weigh bridge at Green Street Green. The anticipated addition of several hundred more cars and service vehicles will inevitably worsen air quality, with potential health implications for local residents. Furthermore, there will be increased noise and nighttime light pollution, as well as accelerated wear and tear on the road surface. This will likely necessitate more frequent maintenance, resulting in further congestion and associated pollution.</p> <p>It is also troubling that the speed limit remains at 50 mph in an area so close to homes and schools, with many drivers maintaining this speed as they travel into Meopham.</p>
