Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	<p>Object principally due inapproriate road access. Access would be into narrow country lane. This is already congested. Approch / junction with A227 would need to be widened, Norwood Lane which would be used by traffic from new development also too narrow and junction with Camer Road would need to be rebuilt as prrsently blond for right turn. Nrw development would require crossings for safe passage of pedestrians, extension 30 mph limit Sole Street to Meopham and possible lights. In short too much highway expenditure and disruption to be justified for 150 houses. This would entail loss of old established hedgerow and mature trees. In consideration with other applications and proposal to develop on fields the other side of Norwood Lane, this would effectively join Sole Street to Meopham with urban sprawll. This is not acceptable. Dvelopments on and feeding into A227 should not be accepted due to present congestion which will anyway increase with construction of new Thames crossing. Additional traffic will worsen danger especially to children attending local schools and crossing Wrotham Road for school buses. Meopham is a village with only village facilities which cannot accommodate the additional population proposed. Meopham station proximity should not be seen to be relevant.</p>

Services are reduced with overcrowding at peak times and line does not serve Gravesend.

New residents to Borough would best be served by housing located nearer to Ebbfleet and Gravesend with a trains to more destinations and high speed rail and bus links.

A227 has been liable to subsidence and flooding.

New development likely to present high risk of flooding and danger to properties adjacent to site.
